ENTRY FORM

Here are the details of the sixth BCPA Clay Shoot. This is a relaxed shoot with the opportunity for some practice and tuition as well as a competition for both individuals and parent /child combinations.

Please bring **your own gun** with insurance and licence certificates if you would like to shoot in the competition. Please let us know in advance if you do not own a gun but would like to take part as we are able to facilitate guns (which will need to be accompanied by an instructor) for a limited number. There will be a small charge for this service (£10).

PRACTICE STANDS

You do not need to apply in advance to shoot on the practice stands. Tuition, guns and cartridges are included. Five clays cost £5.

COMPETITION

Please let us know **in advance** if you would like to take part in the competition. The competition consists of varied pairs followed by a 26 bird flush with a total of 50 clays being shot by each competitor. You can enter as a team of two or as an individual.

It is, however, possible for individuals to shoot outside a team in the individual competition. Anyone who participates in the team competition will automatically be entered into the individual competition. There is a separate novice competition which follows the same format. A novice competitor must be new to the sport or a casual shooter.

Please note that refund can only be made if competitor cancels before Friday 17 February.

Safety and Competition Rules

Competitors:

- All competitors must wear hearing and eye protection
- Competitors are advised to wear head protection
- All spent cartridges are to be placed in the bins provided
- Guns are to be broken and empty at all times unless in the shooting stand facing out across the shooting range
- Only shoot at the target(s) presented for the stand.

Spectators:

- It is advised all spectators wear hearing and eye protection
- Spectators are advised to wear head protection
- All spectators to respect all safety barriers

Competition Rules:

- Clay presentation dictates whether they are released on report or on a call from the competitor. This will be consistent for all guns.
- On each stand the first competitor will shoot four pairs after which the second competitor shoots four pairs. For the 26 bird flush competitors shoot in tandem.
- There will be a total of 50 targets per person, 100 per team.
- Clays and cartridges will be provided and are included in the entry fee.
- Guns are also available at no extra charge.
- Gun licences should be shown on entry
- The Referee's decision is final
- 'On report' targets will be marked as hit or missed
- Doubles, if there is a broken target, pair to be repeated and scores will be established
- Competitors may only 'see' a bird (i.e. watch a dummy clay) if no one has been shooting on the stand before them
- Cards are scored and signed by the marker at each stand.
- Competitors may compete as many times as they like.
- No practice shots on the competition stands.

- Novice Competition Team Prize
- Best individual score for experienced and novice shots
